

Finding your router IP address

Your router IP address will be in the form 192.168.nnn.n . For example, 192.168.120.1

Connect your phone, tablet or laptop to the wifi. A phone or tablet is better for this job.

If you have an Apple iPad or iPhone

1. Go to settings
2. Go to Wi-Fi
3. Press the i next to the name of the Cambium wifi you are connected to
4. Under IPV4 addresses, the router IP address is the fourth in the list

If you have an Android tablet or phone (ie any smartphone that isn't an Apple)

1. Go to settings
2. Go to wifi
3. Above the name of the Cambium wifi you are connected to, press advanced
4. When you see the IP address of your phone, something like 192.168.120.37, you can work out your router IP address: you simply replace the last bit of this with 1, so the answer in this case is 192.168.120.1

Using a windows 10 laptop,

1. Go to settings
2. Go to network and internet
3. Go to wifi
4. Click on the name of the Cambium network you are connected to
5. You will see the network profile. Look for the IPV4 address at the bottom, something like 192.168.120.37, you can work out your router IP address: you simply replace the last bit of this with 1, so the answer in this case is 192.168.120.1
